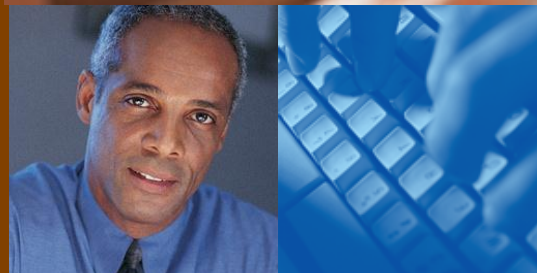

District Director and Manager Terms

- The term of office for the district directors and district managers shall be for two fiscal years following their election or appointment
- No district director or district manager shall serve more than two consecutive terms (four years) in the same position.

District Director Nomination



- The new District Director process asks for a Nomination Committee that is formed by two BOD members, selected by the BOD, the outgoing District Director, and two Chapter Presidents of the District.
- Since in our District, one of the BOD members selected by the BOD is the same as the outgoing District Director **we needed three Chapter Presidents that will be willing to serve in this committee.**

The Candidate/Candidates presented by the Nomination Committee need a 51% vote (Approval) from the District Chapters

District Director Qualifications



Required Qualifications

1. The candidate must be a voting member of APICS in good standing.
2. District Director candidates must have a four-year college degree plus 4 years related work experience or at least 8 years of related managerial experience in supply chain and or operations management.
3. Candidates must have three years experience in a position of cross-functional responsibilities and demonstrated ability to work in a team environment.
4. Each candidate for this office will have six of the nine preferred qualifications, which follow.

Preferred Qualifications

1. Professional certification.
2. Six years of managerial experience.
3. Experience with financial management and budgeting.
4. Ability to formulate objectives and priorities, and implements plans consistent with the long-term interests of the organization in a global environment.
5. Ability to take a long-term view and build a shared vision with others; acts as a catalyst for organizational change.
6. Influences others to translate vision into action. Applies global perspective, considers broad impacts of decisions.
7. Ability to lead people toward meeting the organization's vision, mission, and goals. Inherent to this qualification is the ability to provide an inclusive workplace that fosters the development of others, facilitates cooperation and teamwork, and supports constructive resolution of conflicts.

District Manager Nomination



- **The chair of the district nominating committee will be appointed by the current district manager and will NOT have a vote.**
 - If the current district manager is a candidate for district manager, then the chapter presidents will select the chair for the District Nominating Committee.
- **Vern Teichroeb is the appointed Chair**
- **Need a 51% vote from Chapters**

District Manager Qualifications



Required Qualifications

1. The candidate must be a voting member of the association (APICS member).
2. The candidate must have five of the nine preferred qualifications, which follow.

Preferred Qualifications

1. Minimum of a four-year college degree or equivalent work experience (6 to 8 years of related managerial experience in the industry)
2. Professional certification
3. Documented experience in operations management
4. Four years of managerial experience, including at least two years in a position of cross-functional responsibilities
5. Demonstrated ability to work in a team environment
6. Effective conflict resolution skills
7. Experience with financial management and budgeting
8. Experience with strategic planning and policy creation
9. Two years of service to APICS (e.g., as district staff, chapter president, or ad hoc committee team leader or member).
